Project Profile: CNRL Froth Treatment Plant

Park Derochie was awarded the insulation & fireproofing scope of work for the Froth Treatment Plant at the CNRL Horizon Site. The project involved the insulation, cladding and fireproofing of all piping, equipment & structural steel within the plant.



The immense size of this project created new & exciting challenges for Park Derochie's infrastructure & personnel; however, as a direct result of our project team's dedication combined with our superior management systems, this project was completed safely, on time and within budget.
